

Celebrating International Women's Day (IWD)

Celebrating International Women's Day has proved to be a successful initiative in engaging female players of all levels to participate in their Regional events. The first National IWD Doubles was held in 2019 and 32 qualifying teams from across nine regions competed at Oxshott. For some teams, it was their first taste of attending a National event. To build on this success, PE introduced the IWD Open Triples, which is open to all PE female members.

In 2025 PE will be hosting both the National IWD Doubles (for Regional qualifying teams) and the IWD Open Triples over one weekend. The IWD Doubles will be played on Saturday 7th June and the Triples on Sunday 8th June at Whitnash PC, Leamington Spa

Guidelines for Regional IWD Doubles

- 1. International Women's Day is celebrated on 08 March every year so most regions choose to hold their event in March. However, regions do have flexibility and hold the event 2 weeks prior to the published Finals day to hold their event.
- 2. The qualifying events are run as Open Doubles, for all female players (including juniors) within the Region. The playing format is at the discretion of the Region.
- 3. To encourage greater participation a PE licence is not required. However, should a team qualify for the national event, any unlicensed players would need to join Petanque England to take part.
- 4. Regions may invite players from adjoining Regions who are not running their own competition.
- 5. Regions with only a few female players may run a combined event.
- 6. Each player may only participate in one Regional event.
- 7. The number of teams qualifying for the National IWD Doubles will be based on entries at the Regional IWD Doubles using the following scale:
- 8. Minimum entry 4 doubles teams = 1 place at the National IWD Doubles

5 - 16 teams = 2 places

17-24 teams = 4 places

25-36 teams = 6 places

- 9. Regions with higher number of team entries, may be asked to send additional teams if entry numbers allow.
- 10. If a qualifying team (or player) is unavailable to play, regions have the discretion to nominate another team (or player) who took part in their regional IWD doubles.
